The Afterlife of Charlotte Browning is a story told first person, ghost—Charlotte Browning. Charlotte's greatest adventure takes place after her death, when she attempts to return to the Earth Plane to assist her cousin, Helen, and bring her Home. The task becomes more than Charlotte bargains for when she is confronted with the angry spirit of her cousin's former husband, Justin. In the process Charlotte learns that love is the strongest influence of life—and death.

This tale depicts a group of 25 people who had been abducted since they were children. Somehow they all ended up in the same rural town in Ohio, 25 years after they were first abducted.
