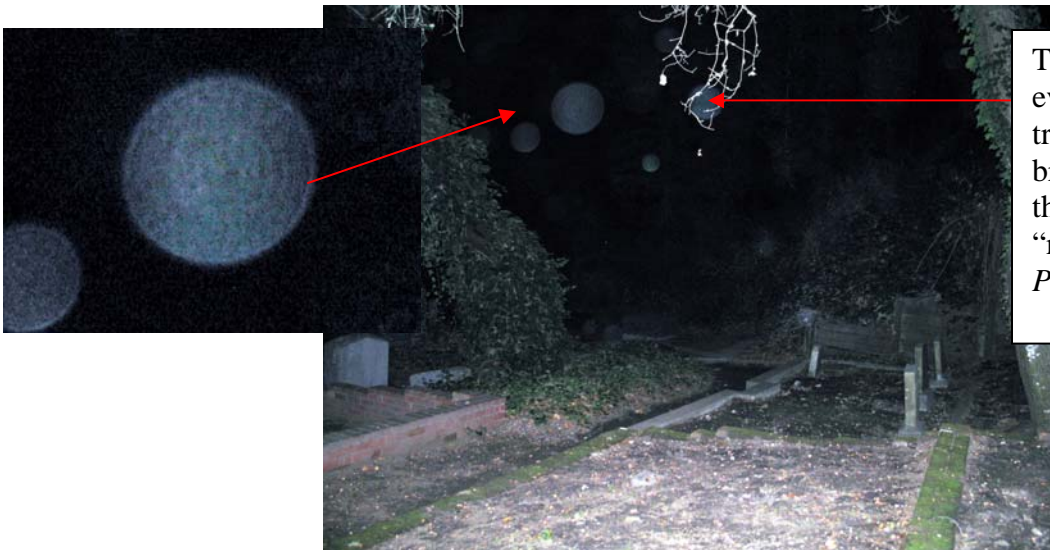
Monterey Bay Area Investigation – October 27, 2007



On Saturday, October 27th Christine B. of El Dorado Paranormal Investigations was asked to be the guest speaker for a PT Cruiser Ghost Cruise sponsored by Dawn and Carol of the Monterey Bay PT Cruisers. Johnny Ellis and his wife Liz drove down from Oakley to join the group, as well. Johnny is a sensitive, and also an owner of a PT Cruiser. Here are some photographs that were taken at The Trout Farm restaurant, The Roaring Camp Railroad, and the Evergreen Cemetery, which were all locations the cruisers visited that day and evening.



Both Johnny and Christine felt an atmospheric disturbance after entering the back room of The Trout Farm. The Gauss meter registered high readings near the back of the room, where the orb shows up in this photograph. After decorating the room, we all left to pick up the other cruisers. When we returned for dinner, the atmosphere felt normal again. None of the other photographs taken at this location showed any orbs, even though many others were taken of the same area. The lights might have caused a lens flare, but the flare would not be that high up in the photograph, considering where the wall lights are located.

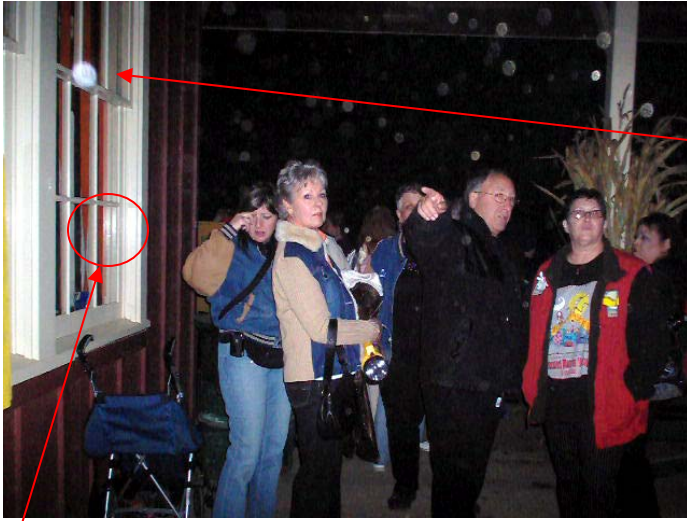
No orbs are visible at the entrance to the Evergreen Cemetery. The group met up here at about 10:30 pm, after the train ride.
