### Dozens Claim They Spotted UFO in Texas

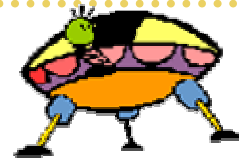
**January 16, 2008** · Faster than a speeding bullet — and bigger than a Wal-Mart. That's how residents near the west Texas town of Stephenville described an object they spotted in the sky one night last week. Dozens of people — including a pilot and a police officer — said a UFO hovered over the farming community for about five minutes last Tuesday before streaking away into the night sky.

## Dozens report seeing UFOs over Texas town

**T** Cue the *Twilight Zone* theme ... Dozens of people say they saw a UFO hovering over their rural community near Stephenville, Texas. The *Stephenville Empire-Tribune* says at least 40 people have reported sightings of the object, which reportedly appeared in the sky just after 6 p.m. on Jan. 8. (2008)

Lee Roy Gaitan, a local police officer, tells the newspaper: *I was outside with my eight-year-old son, Ryan, when I saw lights. It was like nothing I've ever seen before. It was dark already. At first it was two red burning glows that went away and then came back on. I went inside to tell my wife. When I came back out I saw something like lights you'd see in a bar. My little boy and I counted and we came up with nine flashes and they were real spread out. But I couldn't see them attached to anything, just the lights. So I went to my pickup and got my binoculars to see if I could see a plane or something. Even with the binoculars there was no outline. It started moving towards Stephenville and moving so fast I had trouble following it with my binoculars. It covered a big area. It sounds crazy but we really saw what we saw.*



The paper has more eyewitness accounts, including this one from pilot Steve Allen: *The ship wasn't really visible and was totally silent, but the lights spanned about a mile long and a half mile wide. The lights went from corner to corner. It was directly above Highway 67 traveling towards Stephenville at a high rate of speed - about 3,000 mph is what I would estimate.*

Chuck Mueller, a helicopter pilot who served in Iraq, says he saw unusual lights on the horizon a few days after the UFO sightings were reported near Stephenville.

Mueller tells KXAS-TV that he was flying a medical helicopter around dusk when "we saw the lights come on, one little orange light, and then another one and another one in sequence across the sky." He was shocked at first, but then concluded that the lights, which appeared to be more than 30 miles northeast of the original sightings, were coming from flares that were dropped over the Brownwood Military Operations Area. (Flares??? Is that like a weather balloon??)

This isn't the first time that strange unidentified lights have been seen in Texas. The Marfa Lights (in Marfa, Texas) have been investigated since they first appeared – and that would be since the 1800s. The unexplained lights have been such a draw to the area that the town now holds the "Marfa Lights Festival" in September. The origin of the lights has never been discovered.

Marfa, Texas is southeast of El Paso, and west of Austin in the high desert. The famous lights are usually seen near U.S. Route 67 on Mitchell Flat east of Marfa. As I mentioned above, these lights have been reported since the 1800s and they continue today. They are most often described as brightly glowing basketball size spheres floating above the ground, or sometimes high in the air. Colors are usually described as white, yellow, orange or red, but green and blue have also been reported. The balls are said to hover at about shoulder height, or to move laterally at low speeds, or sometimes to shoot around rapidly in any direction. They often appear in pairs or groups and have been seen to divide into pairs or merge together, to disappear and reappear, and sometimes to move in seemingly regular patterns. Sightings are reported ten to twenty times a year. They are not seen during the day and only appear after dark.

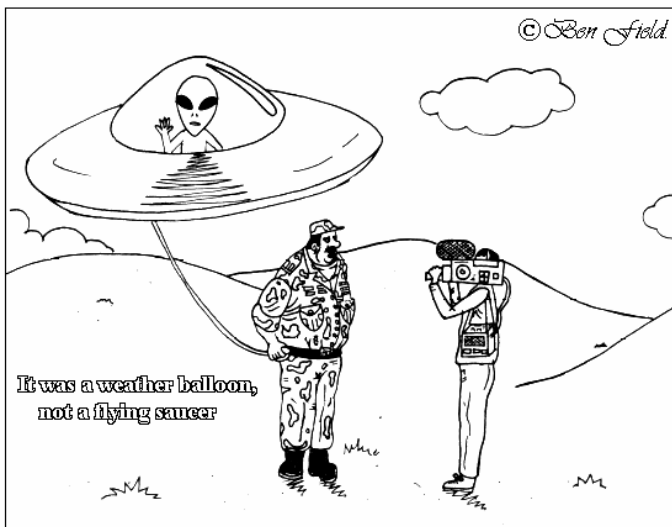


Could the Marfa lights be headlights or tail lights from vehicles traveling up and down Rt. 67? Possibly, but when was the last time you saw yellow, green, blue or orange lights on an automobile? Also, headlights don't usually dart up and down and zoom away in different directions; nor do they merge together and at times divide. Also, if the mysterious light formations were from passing cars, they would be seen every night, not just on certain occasions.

Just another mystery that has not yet been solved.

One of the great things about eating at the Moss Beach Distillery in Moss Beach, CA is that they embrace the fact that they are haunted. The employees are encouraged to discuss the ghost and they even give you a four-page hand out that details their resident spirits in detail. To make your dining experience more entertaining, the owners have rigged up the stained glass chandlers above the bar to move seemingly of their own accord.

The NBC TV series, "Unsolved Mysteries" has done a segment about the Blue Lady who reportedly haunts the restaurant. Famous psychic, Sylvia Brown visited the infamous eatery and not only contacted the spirit of the Blue Lady, but also the spirit of her lover, his other lover, and an elderly woman.

Many mysterious and unexplained events have occurred at the restaurant, including: items floating through the air, sounds of things being moved over the floor when no one else was in the place, computer glitches that dated everything 1927 the year the restaurant opened as "Frank's Roadhouse," doors being blocked by cases of wine that no one claims to have put there, employees hearing their names whispered when no one is with them, faucets being turned on by unseen hands, lights that flicker, doors that slam, and the Lady in Blue appearing to guests outside on the cliffs and inside in the rest rooms.

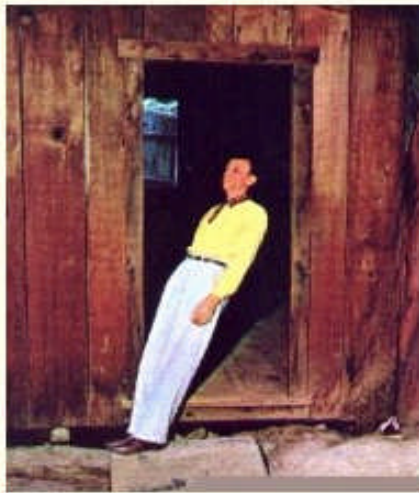
**The Legend:** 80 years ago a beautiful young woman met a handsome man and feel passionately in love with him. The man was a piano player at a local bar. The woman always dressed in blue and was already married to someone else. The two lovers had secret rendezvous at the Marine View Beach Hotel that used to be located next to the Distillery. During a November storm the Lady in Blue died in a horrible car accident near their favorite meeting place. She died without knowing that her piano player lover was also having an affair with another local woman. His second lover discovered the man's betrayal and flung herself off the cliffs into the ocean. All three spirits have been seen at the popular restaurant.

*I ate at the Distillery in May of 2008 and took several photos of the inside and outside of the building. I sensed the spirit of a woman on the rocks that can be seen from the restaurant, but nothing else. Whether you believe in the existence of the Blue Lady and her spirit friends or not, it's an interesting place to eat. Most of the tables offer lovely views of the ocean and they build fires outside on the first floor patio to ward off the chill of the ocean breezes. If you go there, bring plenty of money as one of their steak entrys is \$49.00! No steak is worth that price, unless the place is haunted!*

## The Mystery Spot, Santa Cruz, CA



The Mystery Spot, located about 30 miles west of San Jose in Santa Cruz, CA is an attraction that is almost as famous as the amusement park on Santa Cruz's wooden boardwalk. So, what's the mystery? Apparently, for some unknown and unexplained reason, compasses go haywire in the area—so much so that when the original owners attempted to build a house on the property in 1939 they encountered all sorts of problems. The first problem was that the surveyor's compasses would not give an accurate reading. Other occurrences include: rain falling to the left of the mystery spot and never on it, trees in the area grow counter clock-wise, instead of their normal clock-wise growth for this hemisphere, and gravitational pull is askew as round items roll up hill.

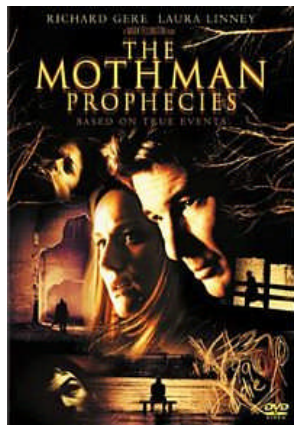
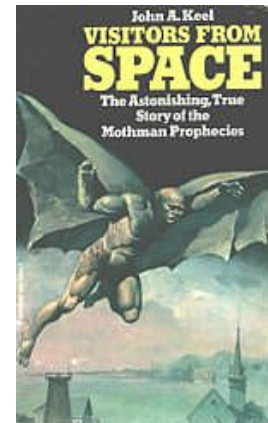

# True or Fairy Tale? The Mothman Prophecies

***The Mothman Prophecies is a book written by journalist and parapsychologist John Keel in 1975. Keel insists that the story is nonfiction.***

The book details events that occurred in Point Pleasant, West Virginia, during 1966 and 1967, and focused on reported sightings of a creature dubbed the Mothman. It also includes Keel's theories about UFOs, Men in Black, ghosts, and other paranormal phenomena, as well as the December 15, 1967, collapse of the Silver Bridge across the Ohio River from Point Pleasant to Gallipolis, Ohio. Forty-six people died in the collapse of the Silver Bridge.



Keel, claiming to be a direct observer of some events, presents some fragments of his own memoir. As such it has been hailed as an innovative work of creative nonfiction. It also raises issues with creative nonfiction since Keel's main theme advocates paranormal phenomena that are attempting to communicate with humans. Some ideas Keel states in his book: "Once you have established a belief, the phenomenon adjusts its manifestations to support that belief and thereby escalate it;" and in later chapters he writes, "I have come to realize that we have been observing complex forces which have always been an essential part of our environment."

The movie by the same name starred Richard Gear as John Keel. If you don't like to read books, (shame on you!) then rent the movie and decide for yourself how much of the Mothman Prophecies is real and how much is Hollywood Hype. I lived in Ohio (Cleveland area) at the time of the collapse of the Silver Bridge and remember the reports about it. That much, at the very least, is true.

Residents claimed that the cause of the bridge collapse was "The Curse of Cornstalk." In 1774, the Battle of Point Pleasant took place between approximately 1,000 white men and 1,000 Indians. The commander of the Indian war party was Chief Cornstalk, a well-respected and intelligent Indian leader. During the battle, Cornstalk could see that defeat was imminent for his forces. He therefore let his troops make a crucial decision, either to fight to the death or surrender. The Indian warriors chose to surrender. With the surrender, Chief Cornstalk signed the Treaty of Camp Charlotte.(16) Chief Cornstalk and his son were later captured and murdered along with his son at Fort Randolph. Legend states that in his dying words Chief Cornstalk, still upset over his troops defeat, placed a curse of death and destruction upon the entire Point Pleasant area.
